

Rahul's pitch for tie-up with AAP in Haryana runs into the Hooda hurdle

THE CONGRESS central leadership's push for a seat-sharing pact with the AAP for the October 5 Haryana Assembly elections seems to have divided the party with its state unit, especially the Bhupinder Hooda faction, strongly opposing the proposal.

The "intense disagreement" within the Congress on the issue, party sources said, even resulted in Hooda, the Haryana Congress Legislature Party (CLP) leader and

ex-chief minister, walking out of one of the party's meetings. Congress sources said the AICC leadership's insistence to deny tickets to some of the sitting party MLAs has also upset

the Hooda camp. Currently, the Congress has 28 MLAs in the 90-member state Assembly. It was said earlier that the Congress's Central Election Committee (CEC) has cleared the tickets of a

SC stays HC order reviving graft charges against two TN ministers

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday stayed the Madras High Court order reviving the corruption charges against Tamil Nadu ministers KKSSR Ramachandran and Thangam Thanasarasu and their spouses. Issuing notice to the Tamil Nadu government on appeals filed by the two ruling DMK leaders, a bench of Justices Hrishikesh Roy and P.Mishra also stayed the HC order setting aside their discharge by the trial court in the disproportionate asset cases. Both the HC orders were passed by a single bench of Justice N Anand Venkatesh on August 7.

In the SC, appearing for the two ministers and their spouses, Senior Advocates Kapi Sibal, A.M Singhvi and S Muralidhar questioned the procedure followed by the HC. They argued the HC, while exercising suo motu criminal revision, could not have held that the closure reports filed by the state's Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption (DVAC) were not acceptable.
