SOON AFTER the Supreme Court
overturned its own 1967 verdict
that Aligarh Muslim University
(AMU) is not a minority institution, Opposition parties welcomed the order with the
Congress calling it a "bold" one,
while the BJP saying that the minority status of the varisty will be
determined by a regular bench.
Senior Congress leader and
Rajya Sabha MP Abhishek
Singhwi said: "It is a bold verdict
which recognises, restores and

Singhvi said: "It is a boto vertice which recognises, restores and continues what was the core genesis of AMU namely compre-hensive, progressive, modern education but with a focus on minorities, who it was felt were deprived of that quality of edu cation. The mere fact that the cation. The mere fact that the Central government gave it added lustre by declaring it to be a Central institution cannot and should not be used to change its basic, original character namely that of a minority. Such rights are recognised in our Constitution and trues high time that the recognised in our Constitution and it was high time that the court definitively settled an issue which was deliberately and somewhat mischievously sought to be unsettled by the powers that be. I am glad that the



court showed tensile strength, Constitutional wisdom, histori-cal depth and a deep commit-ment to abiding by Constitutional values especially secularism and fraternity and

secularism and fraternity and came to the right majority con-clusion, albeit with a dissent." On the possible impact of this order on other minority institu-tions, Singhvi said: "Indeed if the court showed this robust court showed this robust Constitutional sense even in a centrally deemed university, the protection of minority institutions would stand enhanced for all other institutions which are not centrally declared ones."

BJP leader Shahnawaz Hussain said: "The Supreme Court has passed an order saying the case should be heard by a regular bench. So, the AMU minority status remains and there has been a lot of discussion about it. Because when you take

help from the Indian government, then the rules applicable everywhere else should apply there too. The order has come, and it will be seen properly and then aregular Bench will be air.

AlMIM president Asaduddin Owaiss aid that it is an important day for Muslims of India, and targeted the BIP for "opposing minority status for AMU for all these years". It is an important day for Muslims of India. The 1967 Judgment had rejected minority status of AMU when in fact it was. Article 30 states that minorities have the right to establish and administer their educational institutions in a man-

tablish and administer their educational institutions in a manner that they deem fit," he said.

Owaisi said that with this verdict, "the right of minorities to educate themselves has been upheld". "I congratulate all students and faculty of AMU today. It does and faculty of AMU today, it does not matter if the university wases-tablished before the Constitution, or if it was set up by a law of the government. It is a minority institution if it was established by minorities. All the arguments of the BJP were rejected, he said. Samajwadf Party spokesperson Abdul Hafeez Candhi said the party welcomes the verdict. "This verdict will pave the way for AMU toget minority status in the future," he said.
