NIA conducts raids at 8 places in state

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) conducted raids at eight locations in Punjab on Wednesday as part of its ongoing investigation into the targeted assassination case, reliable sources said here today.
The raids that started early in the morning were underway till the closing of the court on Wednesday. A senior official said, the raids "aimed at cracking down on individuals and networks suspected of facilitating criminal activities related to terror organisations. This follows the agency's intensified efforts to study operating links between individuals and terror groups operating in the region".
The NIA today conducted a raid at the residence of one Anandjeet Singh in the Bahawalpur district (opposite of Mukesh Anandjeet's residence) linked to the NIA raid in connection with a case registered under the SCOP Act. The raid reportedly led to the arrest of one NIA officer and one individual. NIA also conducted a raid at the Central Jail in Patna, Bihar. The team arrested high-ranking members of the jail and released Mukesh Singh, alias 'Korin', who was arrested in Chandigarh. Mukesh Singh is Bahawalpur district who had been booked under Sections 40, 41 and 347 of the IPC and various provisions of the Arms Act.

AAP announces first list of 784 candidates for civic elections

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Punjab announced the first list of candidates for the upcoming Urban Local Bodies elections on Wednesday.
The election list covers 47 constituencies across municipal corporations and committees, along with 49 Sub-Township (ST) wards. The election includes 127 constituencies.
Punjab AAP president, Anandjeet Singh, accompanied by working president and Punjab MLA Anandjeet Singh, Sheryn Kaur, state secretary Gurpreet Singh, and other AAP leaders, expressed confidence in the party's preparation and its manifesto, candidate selection process.
AAP has adopted a grassroots approach to select candidates. "We received an overwhelming response with over 1,500 applications for 127 wards in just a few days. In some wards, we received 15-20 applications per ward. This reflects the people's faith in our government and policies," Anandjeet Singh said.
AAP has finalized candidates for 784 wards, with 100 applications per ward.
