

Sangam Nose emerges as favourite spot for holy dip

Devotees from all directions prioritised the Sangam Nose for Amrit Snan and flocked there.

More than three crore devotees took a holy dip on January 13, the first bathing festival of Poush Purnima; and January 14, the first Amrit Snan of the Maha Kumbh, the officials said.

MAHAKUMBH NAGAR: Sangam Nose where saints and spiritual leaders from various Akharas also performed their ritual baths has emerged as the favourite spot for the holy dip during the Maha Kumbh here.

This seamless coexistence of saints and devotees at the Sangam Nose became a reality due to the tireless efforts of the Irrigation Department, Mechanical Barrage Mechanical Section Maintenance, Varanasi, officials said here. The team expanded 26 hectares of land between the Shastri Bridge and Sangam Nose, with two hectares exclusively added at the Sangam Nose in just 85 days by working round-the-clock in three shifts, they said. This meticulous planning and execution allowed saints and devotees to share the sacred experience of the Amrit Snan

harmoniously, highlighting the exceptional arrangements made for this grand spiritual event, they said. This expansion, achieved by placing sandbags over a 1,650-metre stretch, allowed for the construction of temporary ghats, enabling more devotees to bathe simultaneously across the Sangam region, the officials said. The team completed the task using four large dredging machines in record time. This effort significantly enhanced the capacity and accessibility of the sacred site for millions of devotees.

FIR against youth for spreading false info about Maha Kumbh

Ballia (UP): A case has been registered against a youth for allegedly spreading false information on social media that 11 devotees died during a Maha Kumbh ritual in Prayagraj, police officials said on Tuesday.

According to police, a First Information Report (FIR) was lodged at Pakdi police station

on the complaint of Station House Officer (SHO) Rajendra Prasad Singh. The accused, identified as Lalu Yadav Sanjeev, was booked under Section 353(2) of the BNS.

Referring to the FIR, the police said a complaint had been made by Avkush Kumar Singh on the social networking platform X on Monday.

Singh reported that the accused, linked to the Samajwadi Party, had posted false information on Facebook. The post alleged that "11 devotees have died of heart attack due to cold at the Maha Kumbh bathing event and the ICU emergency camps are overcrowded with patients".

giving a road map to the people. I hope that this time the people of Delhi will give a chance to Congress," he said.

Pilot said that people remember the development work done by the Congress government headed by Sheila Dikshit. "The development that happened during that time is still remembered by people. Congress did not let development stop," he said. On a possible rift within the INDIA bloc, he said that all the parties that stand against the BJP and its National Democratic Alliance are still together.

NEW DELHI: Former environment minister Jairam Ramesh noted on Tuesday that the India Meteorological Department's (IMD) computational capabilities have increased in recent decades and called for a major renewal of its organisational structure.

Climate change is having a profound impact on the behaviour of monsoon, which is and will continue to be of critical importance to the country's fortunes, the Congress leader said in a post on X.

"Long Period Averages of the quantum of rainfall may not have varied much over the years but its variability clearly has. The frequency of extreme events has definitely increased. There is, broadly speaking, the same amount of rainfall but in a decidedly lower time period," he said.

This has many implications, especially for agri-planning and groundwater and urban management, Ramesh added.

"The IMD's computational capabilities have

increased in recent decades. This has to be expanded even faster. Its organisational structure needs major

The court was hearing the case against the man and his brother, accused of the cruelty and rape, respectively. According to the woman, the husband and his relatives harassed and assaulted her for dowry after the marriage in November, 2020.
