Expected Sajjan Kumar to get death penalty, say riot victims

NEERAJ BAGGA TRIBUNE NEWS SERVICE **AMRITSAR, FEBRUARY 25** After a special court awarded life imprisonment to former Congress MP Sajjan Kumar in connection with the murder of a father-son duo in the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, victims settled here said justice was delivered extremely late. The SGPC welcomed the punishment awarded to Delhi Sikh massacre accused Sajjan Kumar. With this decision, the families of the victims, which had been waiting for justice for four decades, would get some relief, said Kulwant Singh Manan, chief secretary of the SGPC. It was expected that the convict would be hanged, but life imprisonment was awarded to him, which was very less compared to his crime. He said the SGPC would continue its legal battle for strict punishment to the accused. He said thousands of Sikhs

area in 1984. Their house was attacked by a mob as they had given shelter to some Sikh families. "Our house was brutally assaulted and he had to live the rest of his life as a handicapped person," she said. Balbir Kaur now resides with her son in Ranjit Avenue, while her daughter Sharanjiti is settled with her husband and three children at Varpal village. Another riot survivor Surjit Singh (65) said Sajjan Kumar used to lead mobs during that period. They were expecting capital punishment for him, he added. At the time of riots, he and his family resided in Etawah (UP). As a 24-year-old youth, he saw his shop being looted. A month later, he visited Delhi and Kanpur and observed the horrendous outcome of the pogrom. He welcomed the Modi government's move to start punishing the accused after the constitution of 14 commissions to probe riots.

HEARING ON AMRITPAL'S PLEA MP Arora to contest Ludhiana (West) bypoll

TRIBUNE NEWS SERVICE **CHANDIGARH, FEBRUARY 25** The Centre has informed the Punjab and Haryana High Court that a 15-member committee, headed by Biplab Kumar Deb, has been constituted by the Lok Sabha Speaker to examine leave applications of all absent MPs, including Amritpal Singh. During the resumed hearing on Amritpal's petition, Additional Solicitor General Satya Pal Jain, accompanied by advocate Dheeraj Jain, told a Bench of Chief Justice Sheel Nago and Justice Sumeet Goel that the committee, formed the previous day, would review the cases of all such MPs. Taking the Centre's statement on record, the HC adjourned the matter to next week. Khador Sahib MP Amrit-

pal Singh is currently lodged in Dibrugarh Central Jail under the National Security Act. In his petition, he has sought permission to attend parliament sessions, arguing that his prolonged absence violated his constitutional right and left his constituency unprotected. He has also pointed out that absence exceeding 60 days could result in his seat being declared vacant, affecting nearly 19 lakh people. He contended that his detention and resultant absence were involuntary, constituting forced exclusion, which undermined the democratic process. Amritpal has further requested authorisation to meet officials and ministers regarding the MP Local Area Development Scheme to address local development projects.

NITIN JAIN TRIBUNE NEWS SERVICE **LUDHIANA, FEBRUARY 25** Rajya Sabha member Sanjeev Arora is all set to enter the state politics by contesting the Ludhiana (West) Assembly bypoll as AAP nominee, it is learnt. A formal announcement to this effect will be made by the party on Wednesday. The seat had fallen vacant following the mysterious death of AAP MLA Gurpreet Bassi Gogi on January 10 night. As per rules, the bypoll to elect a new MLA for the vacant seat has to be held within six months. AAP sources said the party high command had chosen the business tycoon-philanthropist-turned-politician Arora (61) for the bypoll. Party supreme Arvind Kejriwal met Arora in New Delhi this afternoon and asked him to contest the bypoll. He reportedly assured him of a key role and responsibility in the state government. Ludhiana native who runs

the "Krishna Pran Breast Cancer Charitable Trust" in memory of his parents, Arora has so far adopted over 300 cancer patients. He is the vice-president of Dayanand Medical College and Hospital. Following the party's ouster from Delhi, the Bhagwant Mann-led state government has been in the eye of a storm with reports of a major rejig or change of guard doing the rounds. "It will be following Arora's entry into state politics that a major reshuffle will take place," party insiders said. According to party sources, Arora's entry into state politics is aimed at consolidating the Hindu vote bank in the light of BJP making inroads into urban areas in Punjab in the recent parliamentary poll.

Weakens federal structure: Resolution rejects Centre's draft agricultural policy

state government has already rejected the policy and sent its reply to the Centre. Since the farmer unions were demanding that a resolution rejecting the policy be passed by the Vidhan Sabha, it was brought up for discussion today. Presenting the resolution to reject the policy, Khudian said as per Entry 28 of List-II (state List) of the Seventh Schedule under Article 246 of the Constitution, agricultural marketing was a state subject. "Our founding fathers had realised that these activities depend on the geographical conditions of a region. These conditions vary from state to state. Therefore, they had rightly put this subject in the state list. This ensures that policies are made according to the specific needs, conditions and challenges of a state... Therefore, framing of the policy by the Centre is against the spirit of the Constitution," he said. Khudian said as far as agricultural marketing was concerned, procurement of wheat and paddy at the MSP remained the most crucial issue. Leader of the Opposition Partap Bajwa said when earlier three farm laws were brought in Parliament, he as a member of the Rajya Sabha had opposed it, saying it was like a death warrant for farmers.

They are not talking of legal guarantee for the MSP. Since people of Punjab have been rejecting the BJP in elections, they are doing everything to discredit Punjab and Punjabis," he said. Mann, suffering from an eye ailment, could not attend the House proceedings yesterday. Today he chose the discussion on the draft policy to hit out at his political opponents in the House, and reply to the Congress assertions yesterday about 32 MLAs being in touch with them to switch sides. "They are daydreaming... they should focus on keeping their stock together. They are not even in contact with their own party cadres or masses. They are the most corrupt and inefficient. Their previous CM was a monarch who remained
